Women in Surgery (WinS) is a national organisation working to promote surgery as a career for women and to enable women who have chosen a career in surgery to achieve their professional goals. We aim:

- to raise the profile of women in surgery
- to work towards an understanding of the issues facing women in surgery
- to encourage attitudinal change ensuring women are seen as an integral part of the profession
- to provide advice, guidance and pastoral support for women already in surgery or considering entering it
- to support the WinS network.

What does WinS do?

WinS works with a number of organisations and bodies to highlight the issues affecting women in surgery and to facilitate change in attitudes and practices to ensure that all of the best candidates are able to succeed in the profession.

WinS maintains a network of members and provides them with a range of benefits, including information and advice on all topics affecting women in surgery or those considering a surgical career.

WinS runs events to support women in, or considering entry to, surgery, starting with workshops for school-age aspiring surgeons through to national conferences.
